## Emergency Kit Requirements

Dear Parents,

Earthquakes are common in California, therefore, all parents are required to supply their child with a small emergency bag. This kit will be stored in the church parking lot.

We recommend that your child be part in putting this kit together. They can help you shop for the things that should be packed in this kit. This way, in case of an emergency, your child will remember that daddy and mommy packed this just for me. This will be a source of comfort and encouragement to your child in case of an earthquake.

The storage space is limited, so please place only the items requested in a Ziploc bag. These kits will be returned to you on the last day of school.

Label the Ziploc bag with your child's name, teacher, and school name.

Please put the following non-perishable items inside the bag:

- \*\*Do not pack any items that contain nuts.\*\*
- \* One protein item your child likes (i.e. can of tuna, chicken)
- \* One fruit item (i.e. small canned fruit, raisins, or fruit roll-up)
- \* One snack item (i.e. crackers)
- One small can of juice. No boxes due to leakage.
- One small bottle of water.
- Plastic spoon and fork.
- \* Emergency blanket. This is a silver blanket folded (small). These are usually found at Target, Wal-Mart, Big 5 (camping section) or sporting good stores.
- Family photo and/or note of comfort.
